The Swiss Network for Dementia Research is an association that was established by Dementia Research Switzerland - Synapsis Foundation in October 2023. The foundation of the network is based on the conviction that pooling existing resources and promoting knowledge exchange between different disciplines will bring new inspiration to dementia research and advance the field.

From the beginning, the network was built around the community, ensuring their voice shaped its conception, planning, and execution. Community insights and recommendations played a crucial role in developing the network and its services.

Our Vision

As a unifying national network, we promote a collaborative and interdisciplinary research culture in Swiss dementia research to facilitate the discovery of new insights and accelerate their translation into clinical practice.

Our Mission

Nowadays, everything seems to be networked - thanks to globalization and technology. Despite the rise of new communication media and technical collaboration possibilities, networking in the scientific field is a challenge. We aim to foster unparalleled relationships, close collaboration, and efficient information exchange between academic and clinical institutions, researchers, and all relevant stakeholders to boost dementia research.

- 1. Strengthen Expertise Exchange: Facilitate expertise sharing within the Swiss research community and with stakeholders
- 2. **Encourage Research Collaboration**: Promote interdisciplinary collaborations within and across Swiss institutions to consolidate resources and expertise.
- 3. **Promote Young Talents:** Support the development of emerging researchers and clinicians in the field of dementia.
- 4. Create Awareness About Dementia: Increase awareness of dementia to improve understanding for relevant stakeholders.
- 5. Align Swiss Research Efforts: Enhance Switzerland's international recognition as a leading partner in dementia research.

Our Services

The network aims to establish a Swiss community that jointly promotes dementia research. To this end different offers will be created that allow to connect research groups and experts from all over Switzerland.







Scientific Events

Community Platform

The Swiss Dementia Community Platform serves as a central hub for dementia research and engagement in Switzerland, connecting key stakeholders — researchers, clinicians, institutions, funding partners, and patient organizations.

The platform features detailed expert profiles, highlights ongoing projects and initiatives, and provides access to recent publications, funding opportunities, job listings, and events. Additionally, it enhances transparency by clarifying who is involved in which research efforts and highlighting completed projects. Young researchers benefit from these resources to build networks and stay informed on field developments. Furthermore, the platform assists users in locating resources such as biosamples, animal models, and diagnostic tools, while supporting the exploration of funding options.

While focused on research, the platform also provides targeted resources for all stakeholders including clinicians. The *Tools & Services* section on the platform supports clinicians by offering guidelines, diagnostic tools, and educational materials relevant to clinical practice. In turn, clinicians contribute to research by sharing available biosamples, study participants, and practical insights — key elements in advancing patient-centered research.

Various communication measures, such as newletters and social media posts, will guarantee a steady dialogue within the community.

Events

We are convinced that a lively community can only be created through personal meetings. For this reason, we will offer various event formats. We are currently planning the first national conference on dementia research, which will bring together researchers and clinicians from all over Switzerland. The event will take place in November 2025. In addition, several webinars and networking events are being prepared, including clinic visits for basic researchers.

Target Group

All experts and stakeholders involved in neurodegenerative disorders, including researchers, clinicians, universities, hospitals, funding partners, societies, patient organizations, and industry.
